## Call for applications – Community member

Are you passionate about the health and safety of the community?

A vacancy for one community member from the Northern Territory (NT) has arisen on the **NT/SA/WA Regional Board of the Psychology Board of Australia (the Regional Board)**.

We are seeking individuals with strong community connections in the NT with an ability and interest to bring a public/lay perspective and voice to the regulatory work of the Regional Board.

**Position details:** The Regional Board makes regulatory decisions regarding notifications (complaints) about individual psychologists under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law, as in force in each state and territory. Members may also be appointed to a national committee.

**Location:** Regional board meetings are usually held in Perth, but may be held online via ZOOM or similar due to the COVID -19 pandemic

**Term of appointment:** Appointments made by the Minister for Health in the NT and are for up to three years, with eligibility for reappointment.

**Remuneration:** Full day sitting fee: Member - \$674 Half day sitting fee: Member - \$337. Government employees are bound by their employer policy regarding payment.

**Eligibility:** A person is not eligible to be appointed as a community member on the NT/SA/WA RegPsyBA if they are currently, or have previously been, a registered psychologist.

**Training and development:** Orientation program and ongoing training provided. Participation at conferences or planning days may be required.

**Application process:** Via application form on the PageUp online platform.
