Stage One	<p>Strategy Consultation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop high-level vision of the Strategy. • Establish the NT Disability Strategy Oversight Group. • Minister formally launches Disability Strategy consultation. • Draft discussion paper launched on NT Government HaveYourSay website. • Office of Disability – Consultation page launched. • Consultation with the disability sector and stakeholders through targeted meetings and engagements – sector requested to encourage input and feedback.
Stage Two	<p>Strategy and First Action Plan Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consultation outcomes published on the Office of Disability consultation webpage and circulated to stakeholders. Including the draft vision, outcomes areas and priorities of the NT Disability Strategy. • Consultations to refine the first action plan under outcomes areas will occur through workshops; and targeted meetings with stakeholders. • A draft 10 Year Strategy Document is produced for finalisation by Oversight Group and NT Disability Advisory Committee.
Stage Three	<p>Strategy Finalisation and First Action Plan Finalisation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public release of the final NT Disability Strategy and first action plan following formal launch by Minister. • The first action plan will include ongoing governance, monitoring and reporting.
Stage Four	<p>NT Disability Strategy – Tools and Support</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development of resources and tools to support community, business, non-government, and government organisations develop their own disability action plans. • Release of tools on website.
Stage Five	<p>Actioning the Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ongoing promotion, engagement and support to drive the Strategy and development of complimentary action plans. • Monitoring and annual reporting of progress and outcomes to the NT Disability Advisory Committee and the Minister for Disabilities.
